



St. Margaret Catholic Cemetery

The cemetery was founded on Oct. 6, 1913, when Frank J. Sensenbrenner donated the land to St. Patrick Congregation for a cemetery. Later, as St. Margaret Mary and St. Gabriel parishes were established, they became joint owners of the cemetery with St. Patrick's Parish.

St. Margaret Catholic Cemetery is located near Main Street and Highway 41 in Neenah, Wisconsin. The entrance to the cemetery is gained through Oak Hill Cemetery on Oakridge Road. St. Margaret Cemetery also has an entrance on the north side of the cemetery.
